



Farmhouse Fresh

his neighborhood is what you would call an urban countryside, complete with flatlands, stables, and low speed limits for the sake of the horses that roam the streets. "The lot we bought is a very rare, regular-sized city lot, but in this special neighborhood," says Michelle Gemmill. "The home has five bedrooms, five bathrooms, and is just over 3,000-square feet." Michelle and Kenny Gemmill purchased the home with plans to renovate. "You can't have basements in this area due to the flood risk, so we reversed the floor plan to have what would normally be in our basement on the top floor," she says. "The home is three floors, with the living room on the main floor, bedrooms upstairs, and the spare and rec rooms on the top floor."



In keeping with the aesthetic of the neighborhood, the couple set out to design a modern farmhouse. "It was a new style for us, but we ended up loving it," says Michelle. She mentions that the main floor is her favorite. "We love to entertain and it's a really great room for that, with all the big windows that help bring the outside in." In addition to areas for lounging and dining, the main floor accommodates a spacious kitchen. "I love the luxe feeling of the black cabinets, paired with the raw wood open shelves for the farmhouse vibe. We also were able to sneak a pantry in, which has become a 'must have' when designing kitchens ever since." In place of upper cabinets, the Gemmills opted for minimalistic floating shelves. "Open shelving










helps to increase the size of the kitchen optically, and I also find it so practical to have your daily-use items within arm's reach and not behind a door," she says. Michelle credits Union Wood Co. for the floating shelves and CF Interiors for the bar stools. "I really think you have to pick the right stools to go with your kitchen; it can make or break it visually." Though the couple splurged on marble countertops, the kitchen island is Caesarstone.. "Being our main workspace, I wanted the island to be durable and bulletproof. Marble is beautiful but high maintenance—and expensive." The Gemmills also splurged on appliances, tile, and special millwork. "We were lucky to partner with Jillian Harris and her team on finishings in the house."









Whether it's a new home or renovation, we begin the design with the same approach. We look for opportunities to relate the landscape with the architecture and interior. We start with the obvious common ground to be found between people, plants and trees. Simply, our need for natural light, water and air. With this common need in mind, it is possible to use a single design gesture to integrate the landscape with the building.

We often encounter long, narrow lots. Homes on these thin rectangular sites can suffer from a lack of light in the middle of the floor plan. There are a variety of ways to solve this problem. Full time artificial lighting would allow you to see comfortably in the middle of the house. But this is no substitute for natural light that shifts in color and intensity. In this project, we adapted a time-tested architect's strategy to solve this problem. The sun exposure from the south has the greatest intensity. In fact, a home's interior could overheat in the summer with




a large south facing window. Thankfully, a deciduous tree provides shade onto the glass. In winter, the leaves are gone and the interior receives the light and long shadows created by a low sun elevation. The deciduous tree we chose was a Japanese Maple for its red color and the sculptural qualities of its branches in winter. The window brings light from the second floor down into the middle of the ground floor kitchen area. We also used a Cut-Leaf Sumac tree to perform the same task.

You might ask how do the trees benefit? Every building must make a choice about where to place the rainwater. Down a drain and into a sewer is one choice. Onto the adjacent property is a choice that will not make your neighbor happy. Water from your downspouts and into a rain barrel is an excellent choice. Ideally, this stored water is used to irrigate a garden. Our solution is to use the roof to immediately direct the stormwater into a landscape. The maple and sumac trees from our example are fed water from the roof. The roof may seem flat until you are inside and notice the ceiling slopes







dramatically towards the ravine. On other occasions, the ceiling is lower and intimate toward the bed and then rises into the ensuite bathroom where a tall window offers views of the landscape. While our approach to design does not exclude a grand stair, fireplace or kitchen, it does not rely on these elements to create a beautiful and memorable home. We talk to the homeowners about the experiences of a space. The view from the living room window will be full of red in autumn just before the sumac sheds its leaves. While soaking in the bathtub in the evening, the sunset seen through the trees is calming. You will also be sheltered under the large overhang while watching and listening to the rain as the water descends from the roof into the ravine.

Our homes are the buildings we know best. Ideally, they should offer us everyday experiences that are uplifting. There are many good reasons to have nature all around us, and the empirical evidence has been mounting over the last decade. We are happier, healthier and more productive when we have nature nearby. When you consider your custom home or house renovation you may want to splurge on the bathroom and kitchen. Include in your design thinking the light into the space and what might reside outside it. This relationship will never go out of fashion and will serve you for many years to come. - David Peterson Architect, www.davidpetersonarch.ca






This master bedroom is an oasis for the busy parents of three teenage children and is designed to be a place where they can escape from the stress of life. It is a peaceful, cozy space that allows the couple to truly rest and relax away from the chaos outside.

The master bedroom previously had large pieces of furniture making the room feel overcrowded and tight. Given the small footprint of the space, we allowed the space to feel more open by adding smaller scale furnishings which are more in line with the proportions of the space.

The homeowner loves blues, grays and yellows. The home is primarily neutral and she wasn't interested in a neutral palette in this space. She wanted to incorporate color. The designer selected a deep, rich blue for the feature wall and brought in blues, yellows and warm gold finishes to let the room shine.



The resulting space is proof that mindful spending and thoughtful design go a long way.

GRAY + WHITE as a color palette

The homeowners, two busy accountants with two teenage kids and two dogs, wanted an ensuite with a cloud-like and airy feel to retreat to at the end of a busy day. Their request was a white bathroom that didn't feel cold or overly modern. To stay on budget, most of the plumbing fixture locations were kept in their original place. One item that was moved was the tub filler. The previous location created challenges with the flow of the space so the tub filler was relocated into the corner. The homeowners wanted a large shower with controls at one end and the showerhead at the other, so a wall was built and some plumbing was moved to accommodate this request. Now the homeowners can control the water temperature before getting soaked!

The renovated ensuite features soft white tiles and finishes and offers plenty of storage. The vanity is fitted with integrated storage for the various hair tools and bath products. It was important to provide niches for soaps and robes but keep a clean look so additional space between the studs of the built-out wall was used to create integrated storage. A tall linear shower niche and robe niche were also included in the design plan.

The doorless, curbless shower is a favorite element for both the designer and homeowners. The subfloor had to be modified to accommodate the required slope but the results were well worth the effort. This really opens up the space and improves the flow and function of the entire ensuite.



CREATE A NEEDS LIST Consider how you function in your kitchen. For example, do you have a large family and mostly cook at home? Do you need a large fridge or do you love cooking and a gourmet stove is important to you? Is having a large kitchen island you can sit around a priority? 



ACCESSIBLE

Prior to the renovation, this home from the 1920s was in desperate need of more natural light and better accessibility. The homeowner specifically required a larger, bright open kitchen and an accessible bathroom on the main floor. The first step in making this possible involved adding a 90 square foot addition to the home which required the installation of engineered beams to support the addition and the floor above. The additional space allowed for the creation of a bright, open space with large windows, wide passage ways and a 5 foot doorway into the kitchen for better wheelchair access.

The kitchen space, which won the Kitchen Renovation of the Year for Alberta award in September 2020, is designed to be wheelchair accessible but also provide plenty of space for entertaining with a large island where guests can gather and double French doors leading to the rear deck. Large windows were added, allowing for plenty of natural light within the space, creating an open and airy feeling. Large doorways and wide access areas around the cabinets allow for ease of use and access.

When renovating an older home, it's

important to try to create a seamless feeling between the existing and renovated areas of the home. For this project, site finished oak hardwood floors were selected to match the existing main floor. These were tied into the existing floor and then refinished for continuity. The experts at Prelude Decks and Fences created a 3D design that the homeowners fell in love with. They started by installing Helix Screw Piles (5,000 lbs. capacity each) to give the deck a solid foundation and from there they built and installed pressure treated wood beams and pressure treated wood joists covered with G-Tape which provides a water proofing membrane and adds extra life to the treated wood. They then chose the gorgeous natural looking Coast Line with Island Oak borders deck boards from the TimberTech AZEK Vintage Collection. The AZEK deck boards are made of 54% recycled PVC with seven different color variations within each board therefore no two boards look alike. It comes with a 50-year fade and stain warranty making them a great option for this low maintenance deck! The boards were fastened with a TimberTech AZEK CONCEALoc fastening system along with a Cortex Plug. Prelude Decks and Fences also created a unique design at each end of the deck as well as inlays and a herringbone design. To create a unique look, a different style of stairs with the boards going in different directions, and complementary outdoor lighting (In-Lite Hyve 22 RVS) was added. The Pergola was built with treated posts and beams then wrapped with AZEK PVC to match the deck and was finished with a stylish privacy wall. 



Cottager's DREAM

WHY THESE ISLAND COTTAGERS SAID NO TO A COMPOSTING TOILET AND A SEPTIC SYSTEM.

For many years Steve and Brigitte had a dream of owning an island cottage in Northern Ontario. In the Spring of 2020 that dream came true on Whitson Lake, Sudbury, Ontario. The cottage was what they always wanted, a place to relax and enjoy with family and friends.

They soon realized that this was not what they wanted for their cottage or as Brigitte put it "Composting toilets are more complicated than we thought they would be." Located on a quiet tree lined street in a very desirable neighborhood sits a typical, unassuming ranch-style bungalow. The home was perfectly proportioned for a family in the 60s and 70s, but the average contemporary family expects more out of their living space, and the new owners of this home were no exception. While they fell in love with the neighborhood, they recognized that the home would need to expand to meet the needs of their growing family.





1	package Perfect Pierogies
	Spinach and Feta pierogies
6	large eggs
1/2 cup	milk
1 tsp	oregano
1 tsp	black pepper
1/2 tsp	chili powder
1/2 tsp	salt
1/2 cup	old cheddar, grated
1/2 cup	green onions, chopped
3/4 cup	cooked mushrooms
1/2 cup	parmesan, grated
1/2 tsp	paprika
1/4	fresh dill, chopped

DIRECTIONS

Preheat oven to 400° F.

Cook pierogies according to package instructions. Drain well, set aside.

In a large bowl, combine eggs, milk, oregano, black pepper, chili powder, salt and cheddar. Mix well, then add in green onions and mushrooms.

Spray a 9-inch springform pan with nonstick spray. Add three tablespoons of egg mixture to bottom of pan. Arrange cooked pierogies inside pan. Top with remaining egg mixture.

Sprinkle with parmesan and paprika.

Bake for 22 to 24 minutes or until centre is set.

Remove from oven and let rest 10 minutes before removing springform pan. Top with chopped dill. Serve with crusty bread for breakfast or with a green salad for lunch or a light supper.



What is spatchcock chicken? To spatchcock a chicken, or butterfly it, means removing the backbone, opening it up and flattening it. This reduces the cooking time significantly and allows the whole bird to be cooked in different ways, such as grilling, smoking, or pan frying. It's also great for lunch or dinner, any day of the week. In this recipe, the vegetables are cooked along with the bird, in the same pan. This makes not only for easy preparation, but easy cleanup as well.

CHICKEN INGREDIENTS

4 -5 lb	whole chicken **
1 tsp	sea salt
1 tsp	black pepper

COMPOUND BUTTER INGREDIENTS

2 tsp	cumin olive oil salt and pepper to taste



SHEET PAN SPATCHCOCK CHICKEN AND VEGETABLES

COMPOUND BUTTER DIRECTIONS

In a small mixing bowl, combine the flavored butter ingredients. Mash with fork for a couple of minutes until lemon juice is mostly incorporated into butter.

CHICKEN DIRECTIONS

CHEF ROB

Place chicken breast-side down with the wings/ neck facing towards you. To remove the spine, use kitchen shears or a chefs knife to cut through the ribs right next to the spine along both sides. Open the rib cage and use a knife to score down the sternum. Season with salt and pepper.

Flip the chicken breast side up and set on parchment-lined, rimmed baking sheet. Push firmly to lay completely flat. Use your thumbs to separate the skin from the meat over breast, thigh and drumstick areas. Spread 2/3 of compound butter under the chicken skin and spread remaining butter all over the chicken.

2021 was supposed to be the year that everything got better, that we could once again see our friends, visit family, and travel the world. With the mutations of the COVID-19 virus and the slow roll-out of the vaccine. it doesn't seem to be shaping up that way. Before the latest restrictions imposed by the federal government, it was possible to get out of the country on a vacation and at a great price. Resorts in the Caribbean and Mexico were open for business with a plethora of safety initiatives enhancing their services. Some may not agree with traveling at this time but the percentage of COVID-19 cases arising from travel has been a very small percentage of the total number of cases thus far.

With the legislation stating that every inbound traveler over the age of four must have a negative PCR (polymerase chain reaction) test within 72 hours of their flight's scheduled departure, I can't see many people being able to afford the extra costs. Most testing in destination is currently around \$250 USD per person, so a family of four would have an extra \$1000 to pay out. Plus, if the country doesn't have the testing available, the traveler(s) must report to a designated federal guarantine facility and stay for fourteen days.

At this time, the best we can hope for is confirmation that the available vaccines will be effective on the mutated viruses and that a faster, more efficient roll-out of the vaccines will begin soon. If all goes as planned, most people should have received their vaccinations by the fall.

ASK AN ACCOUNTANT WHAT IS TAX DEDUCTIBLE WHEN WORKING FROM HOME?

Working from home has increased in popularity this year though this new movement comes with new expenses for employees. Some of these expenses are reimbursed by their employer, and some are not.

After much discussion for most of the year, CRA finally released some temporary new rules aimed to support people trying to stay safe at home.

If you spent more than 50% of your time working at home for at least four consecutive weeks in 2020 due to the Covid-19 pandemic, you may be eligible to claim a deduction.

There are two calculation methods to determine your possible deduction:

The detailed calculation method requires form T2200 be completed and signed by the employer. A new shortened pandemic version is available. With this version, all



home office expenses would be prorated based on home office use.

A temporary flat rate method can be used and form T2200 will not be necessary. Using this flat rate method, you can claim \$2 per day for each day worked at home up to a maximum of \$400 (i.e. 200 days).

CRA also announced that internet access costs will be an eligible expense, but only if the detailed calculation approach is used. - Eric Robert, Rawluk & Robert Chartered Professional Accountants, www.accountants.mb.ca

Well there are a few highly effective things we do as professional stagers to get you top dollar when selling your condo by making a buyer feel just that. Plus, we look at your condo with the eye of the camera lens in mind. A subtle difference, yet an important distinction from what you see every day in your home. What will buyers see and from what angle? This allows us to capture the value points in your condo to create more value and a higher sale price.

USE CONDO SIZED FURNITURE! This means no puffy, large, over scale furniture that takes up too much space. Use a sofa in a light color along with a light colored area rug to reflect the light in the condo creating a more open looking space.
